**Updating of ARMA Member IDs:** We have finished updating the Mile High Denver Chapter website with the new ARMA International Member IDs. You should now be able to login to the Mile High Denver Chapter website also using your new ARMA International Member ID.

When logging into the Member Area of our website you can choose one of three ways:

1. By using your new Mile High Denver Chapter ARMA ID, which is also the same as your new ARMA International Member ID
2. By using your Email Address, the Email Address that is on file with ARMA International
3. By using a Username, if you have already set one up

If any of your member information isn't correct on our local website, please update your information at ARMA International's website. Then when we import a new list, your information should appear correct on our local website. We will be importing a new list every month, or as needed, so that we keep our Member List current.

If you have forgotten your Username/Password, there is a link to click which will ask for your Email Address so that you can reset your password. If you have never logged into the local website before, we may need to setup a password for you.
